More than 20 national and budget arrives fly to Riga. Travel by train from Western Europe is slow with services typically going via Berlin and Warsaw. There's also a ferry from Stockholm.

Times have changed since Riga's tourist board peoclaimed that 'canned sprats' were one of the Larvian capital's chief attractions. The European Union member adopted the Euro currency in 2014 and is one of a trio of post-Communist Baltic states that grasped the opportunities of capitalism with both hands and became a bar-hopping stag-party stagle. But it has since developed into a sophisticated destination with cool cases and restaurants.

You'll find a colourful city centre rich in history and art. The Art Museum Riga Bourse displays treasures spanning 7000 years of history, from Asian orramics to Old Masters. The old town itself has UNESCO World Heritage status thanks to buildings dating from the city's foundation in 1201 and an unparalleled art nouveau neighbourhood that was once home to isaiah Berlin, political philosopher. Take a stroll down Alberta Iela (Albert Street) to see some of the best art nouveau decoration in the city, much of it crafted by architect Mikhail Eisenstein. The 700-year old Dome cathedral is one of the Riga's landmarks but there are several

fascinating museums dealing with the Soviet and Nazi occupations and how the country's Jewish population fared.

Extreme Sports in Latvia

Adventures in Latvia are not limited to Riga's nightlife; 48km (30 miles) northeast of Riga is the country's main hub for adventure sports, Siguida (there is a direct train service and driving there will take about an hour). This mountain town is the gateway to the Gauya National Park, In winter this is the principal spot for winter sports while in the summer the River Gauya becomes the centre of attention for canoeists and kayakers. The river flows through deep sandstone gorges and you can camp along its length. Keep an eye out for the wildlife: peregrines, trout, salmon and otters. Even wilder, Sigulda boasts an Olympic standard bobsleigh track. It is one of the few tracks that allow members of the public to test their nerve against the clock and gravity. In the summer the bobsleigh runs on wheels but in the winter the track is clad in ice.
