





Modigliani studied under master painter Guglielmo Micheli from 1898 to 1900. In 1902, he enrolled in the Accademia di Belle Arti in Florence.


In 1903, he moved to Venice to study at the Istituto di Belle Arti.

In 1909, he temporarily gave up painting to become a sculptor. He exhibited his sculptures at the Salon d'Automne of 1912.


