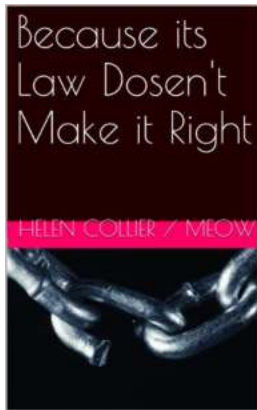
Natural Law
