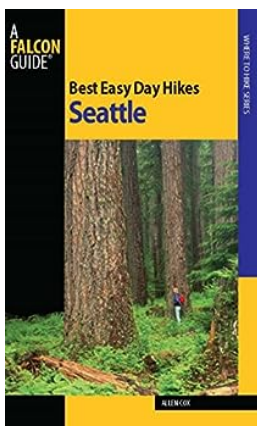

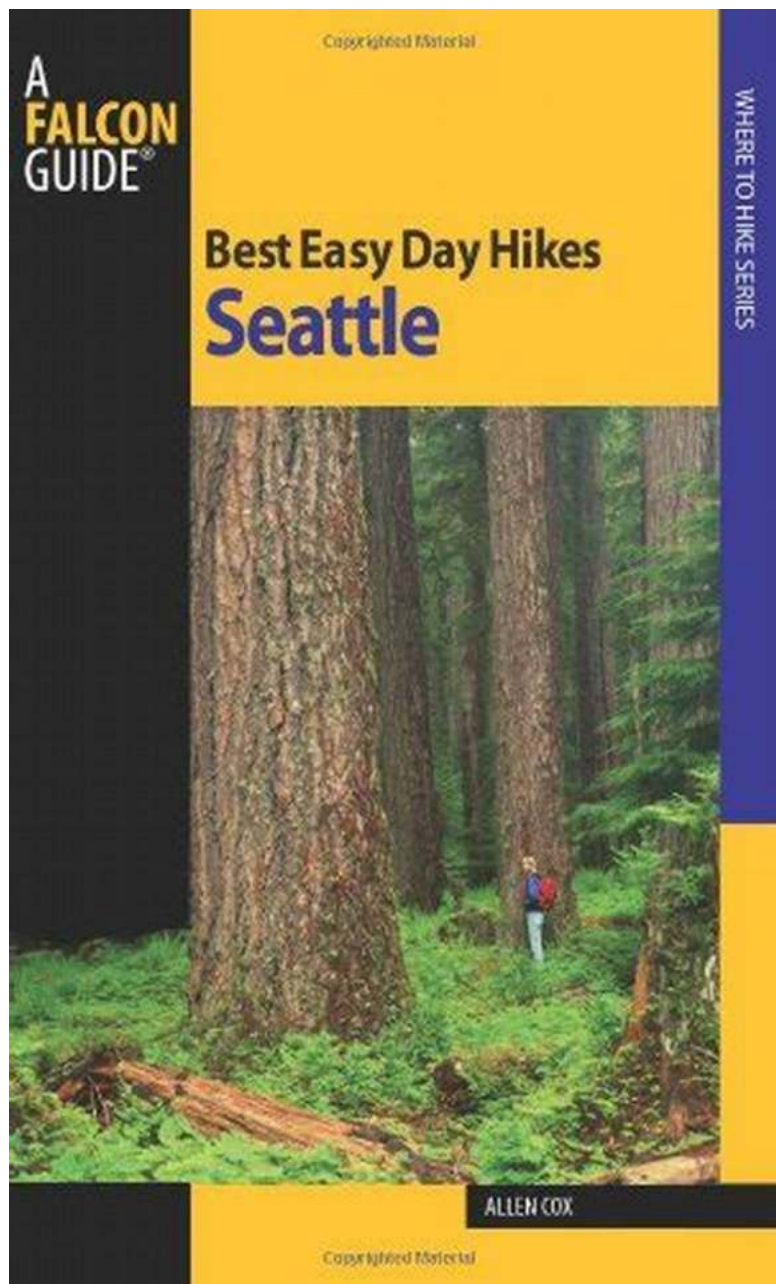

2. Rattlesnake Ledge



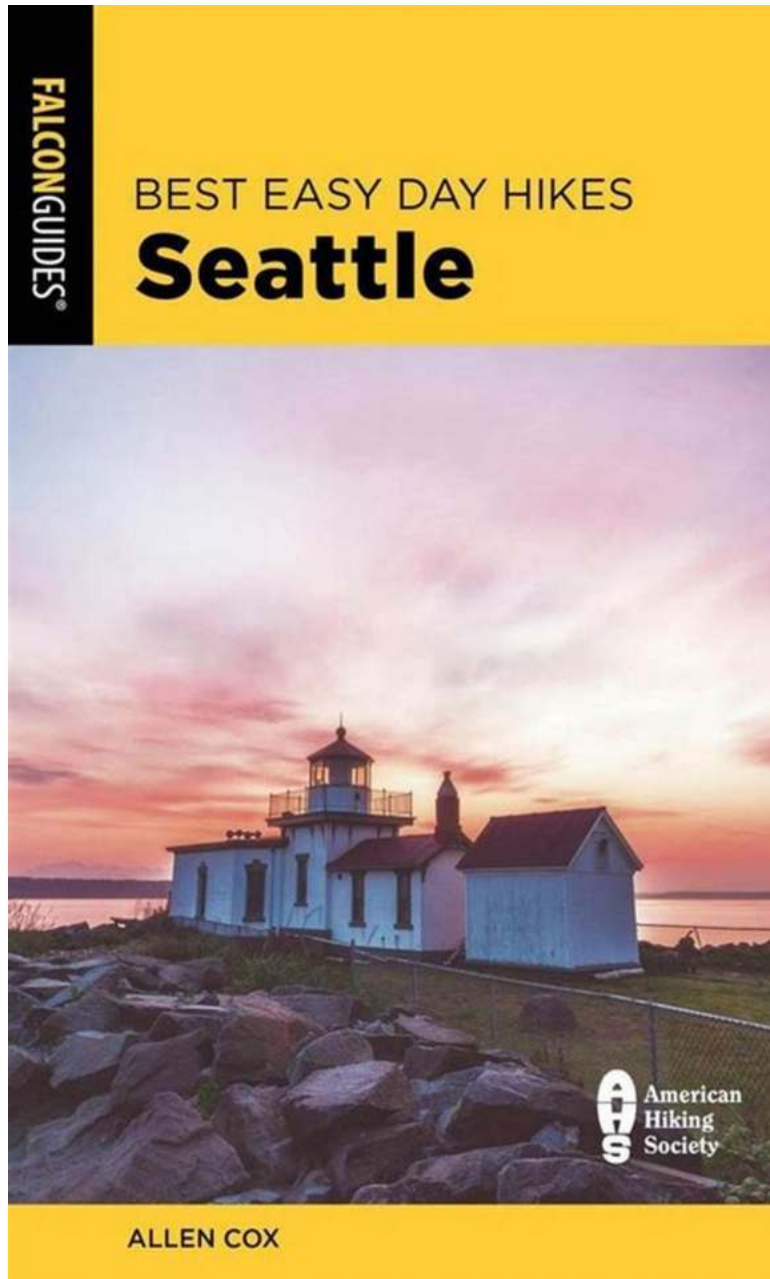

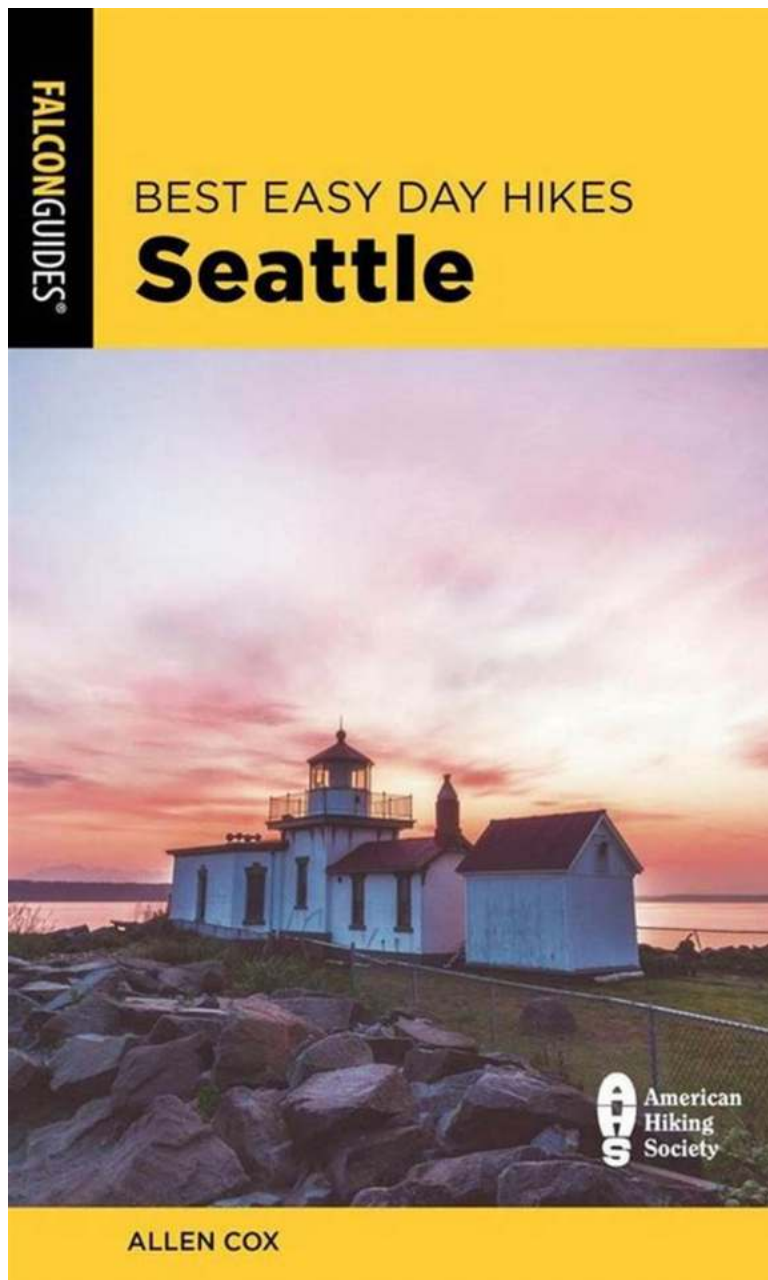

5. Mount Si

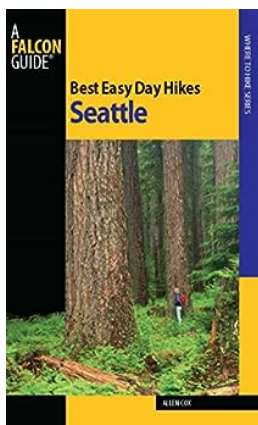
