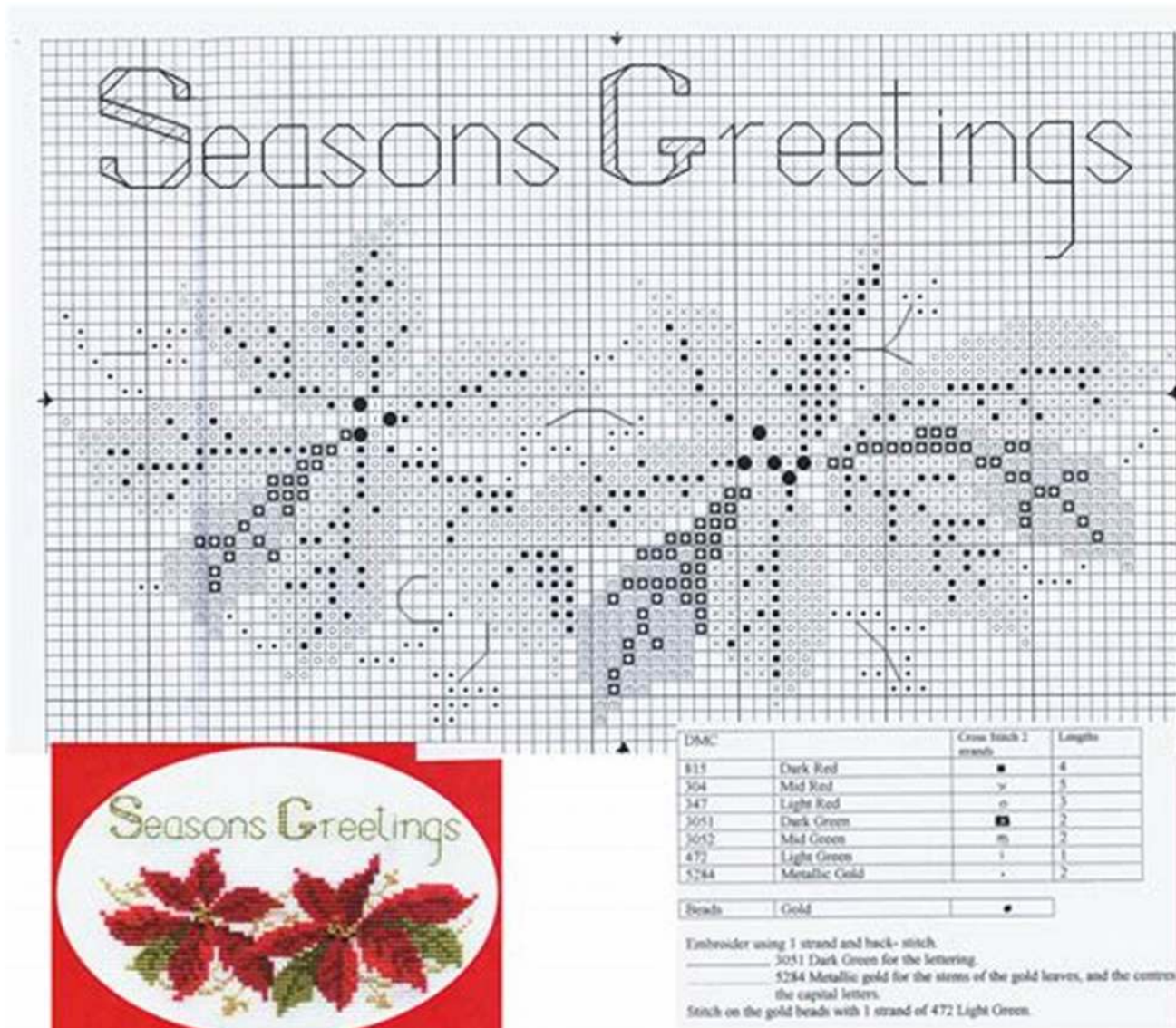

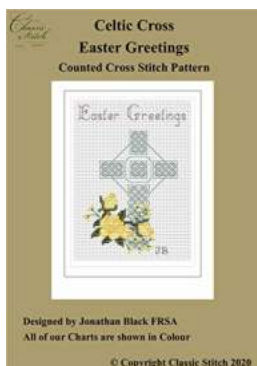

A cross stitch pattern of Celtic Cross Easter Greetings

Included in the Key there is a choice of six different colours, that you could choose to stitch the flowers in. Depending on what occasion you are using the card for. You could also if you wanted to, do each flower a different colour, making the card even more colourful. You could if you wished to stitch the Celtic cross in another colour that you would prefer, please make sure that it will show up before you begin to stitch.

This card has been stitched on 14 Count Zweigart canvass, however, it can be stitched on any count of canvass, or any colour canvass. Please make sure that before stitching, that your finished card will show up on your chosen colour of canvass. The heading on this card, is just a suggestion, you can use any heading that you choose. To help with this two different alphabets are included, together with a grid, a copy of which can also be downloaded from our website <https://www.classic-stitch.com>. This is to make sure that your chosen wording will fit into the finished card, before starting to stitch. You could add the person's name, date of birth as an example, to make the card unique. Also included is a copy of a list of anniversaries, birthstones and birth flowers, that you may find useful, if you would like to make the card even more unique and personal to the person who you are stitching it for. Whilst every care has been taken to ensure that the information is correct, we can take no responsibility for this. This chart can be used as card or as a small picture.

Included is a full chart in colour together with a key and full instructions on how to complete each stitch. The charts can be made bigger on your Kindle to help to

see the symbols more clearly. This pattern does include fractional stitches, with the instructions on how to work the, stitches a beginner and a more experience stitcher will be able to complete the finished card. All that is needed is time and patience.

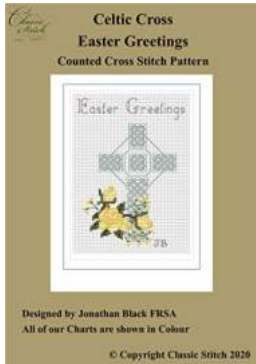
