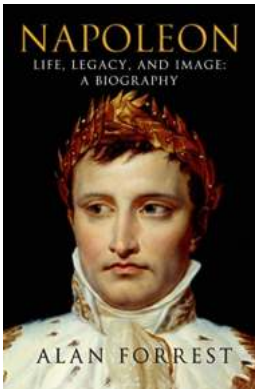
When *American Falconry* magazine came along, I suggested to the editors that I write a column for the apprentice falconer. I submitted a few articles to show them

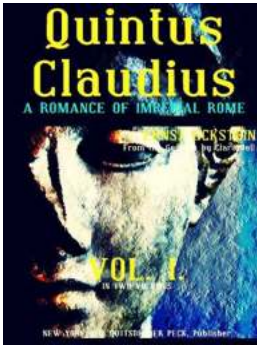

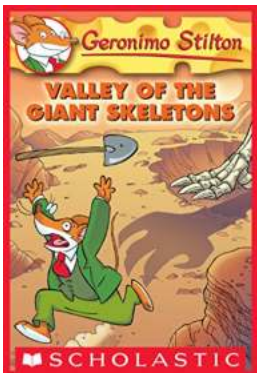

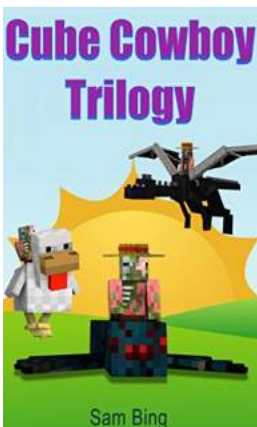
