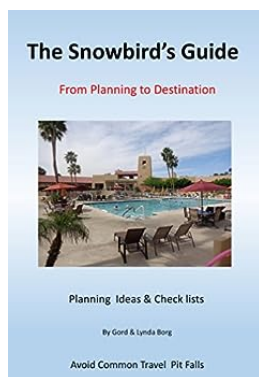

In order to ensure a comfortable journey with your pet, ANA recommends that you prepare the following items in advance.

- Familiar pet food, dietetic pet food
- Familiar pet snacks
- Watering device (with nozzle)
- Food trays, etc.

Transport

- Pet cage
- Collar, lead
- Identification tag

Hygiene

- Pet cage liner sheets
- Waste disposal items

Other Useful Items

- Favorite toys
- Medicines that your pet may need
- Brush
- Cooling mat (summer)
- Heat packs (winter)

Please note that there is a possibility that your pet may accidentally ingest toys due to the stress caused by the change in environment, etc. Also, please remove any collars and leads before check-in.

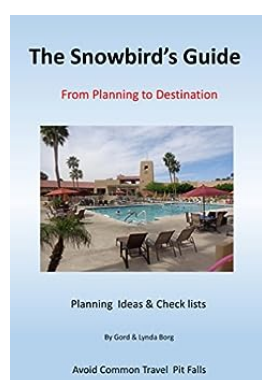
