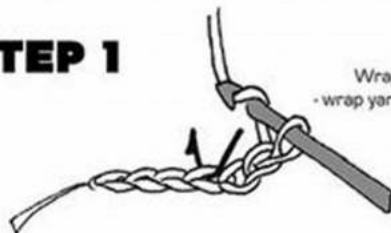

STEP 2



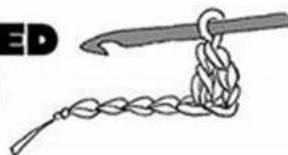
Wrap yarn again and only
pull through two loops on hook.

STEP 3



Wrap yarn once again and pull
through last two loops on hook.
