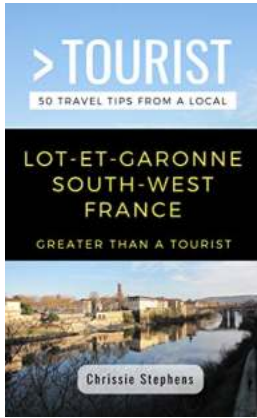
Our Story
