Frequently compared to William Faulkner and Gabriel García Márquez, Rolando Hinojosa is required reading for anyone interested in life along the Texas-Mexico border in the twentieth century.





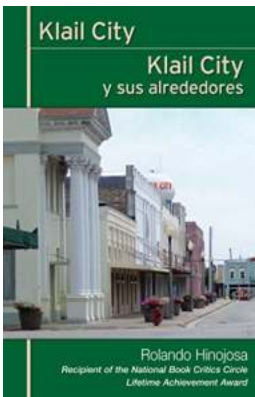
