

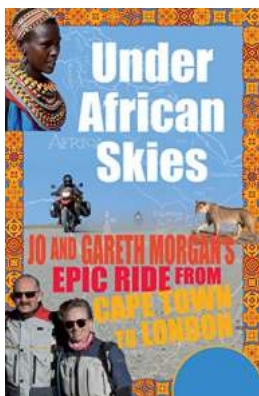

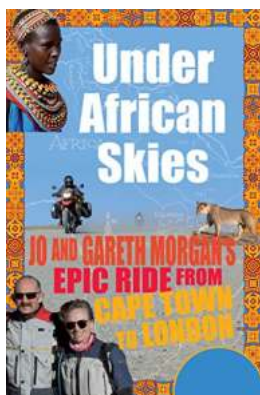

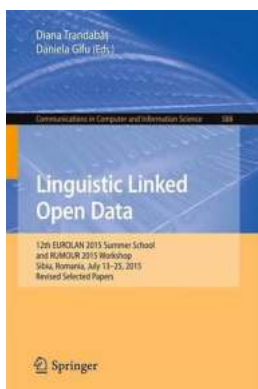
(and a wander in Rwanda). They dodged guerillas (and hung out with gorillas). They were in for a shock (or four) on Kenya's road to hell...
