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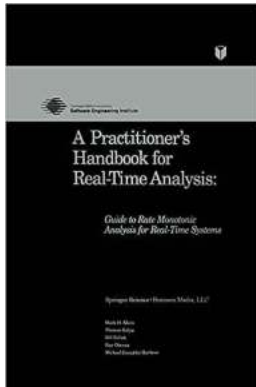
Far Away in the Andes is the first work for the TERRA INCOGNITA Collection, and the third of a series of volumes under the same title.

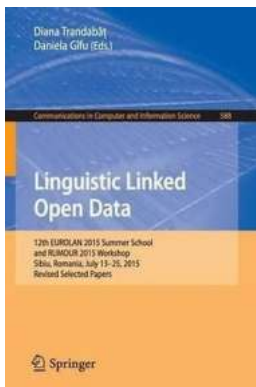
be discovered.

Also, limited edition, luxury photographic portfolios and single Fine Art copies will be offered for sale.



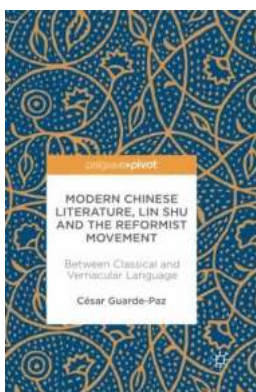
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
