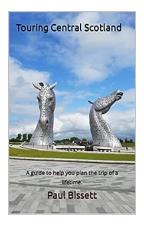

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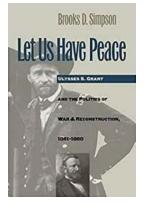

miles away.

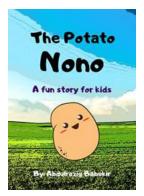
That's what I have tried to address in this book, by listing every major attraction and many minor ones within geographical areas, you will know what is close by and won't miss something that you will regret later.

I have also listed many sites that are free to enter.



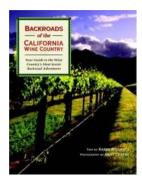
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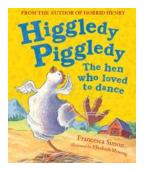
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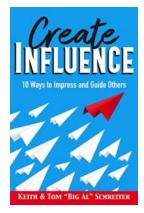
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
