

Step 1: Learn the Scrum Roles

Scrum utilizes three main artifacts: the Product Backlog, the Sprint Backlog, and the Increment.



- Increment: The Increment is the sum of all completed Product Backlog items during a Sprint. It represents a potentially releasable version of the product with increased functionality and value.






