

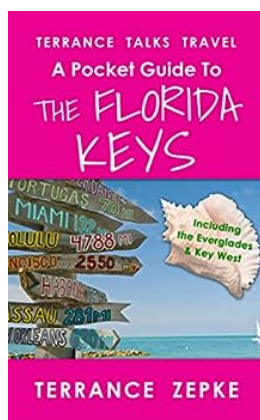

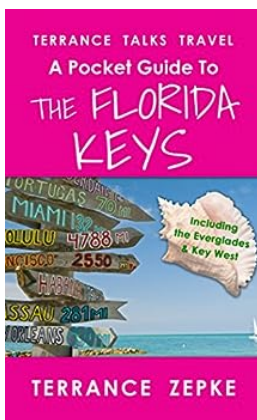

*Go sportfishing in Islamorada, which is known as the 'Fishing Capital of the World" and ranked #1 fishing destination by anglers across America.

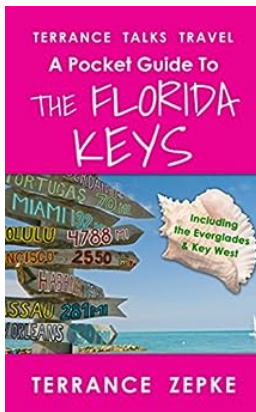
