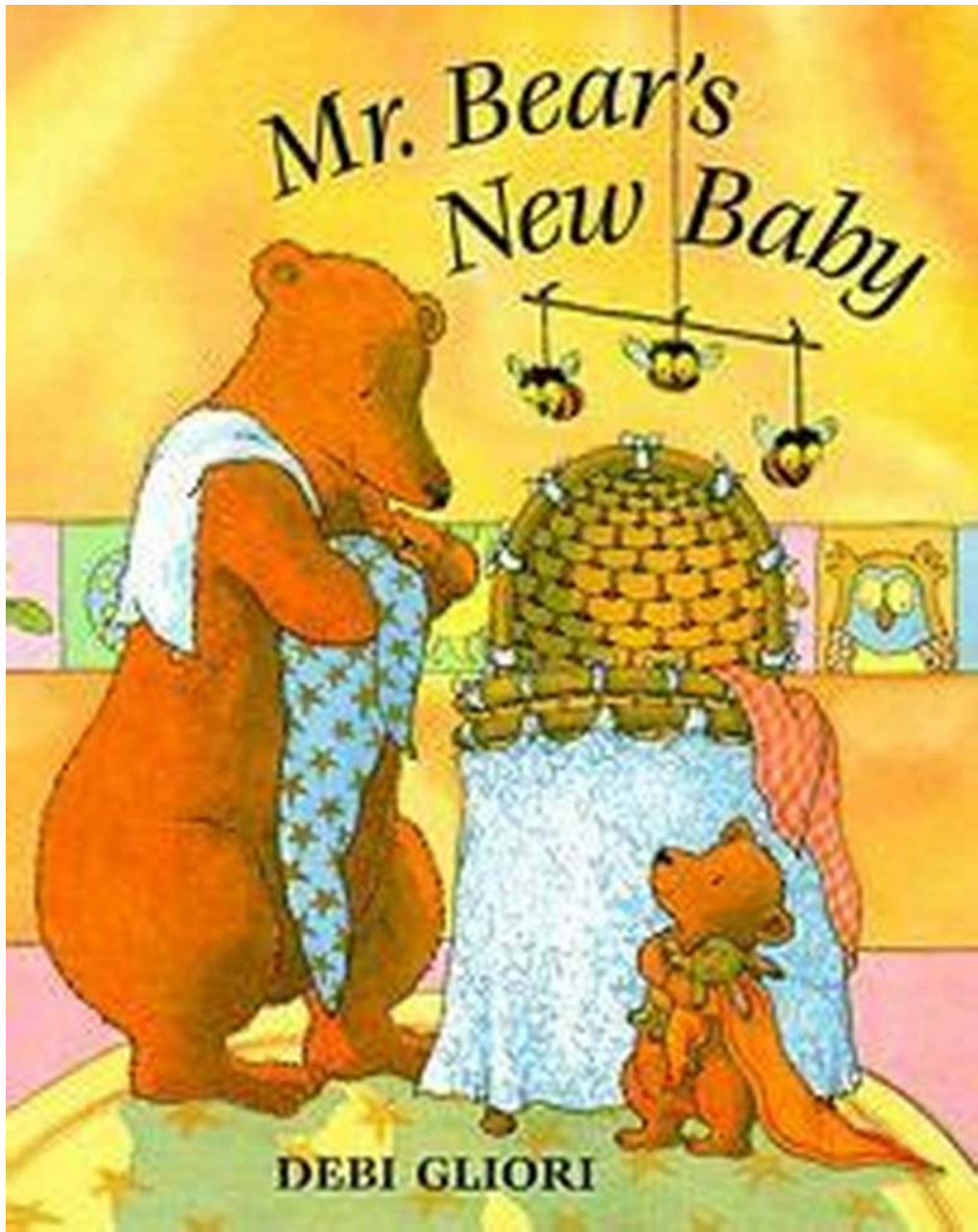

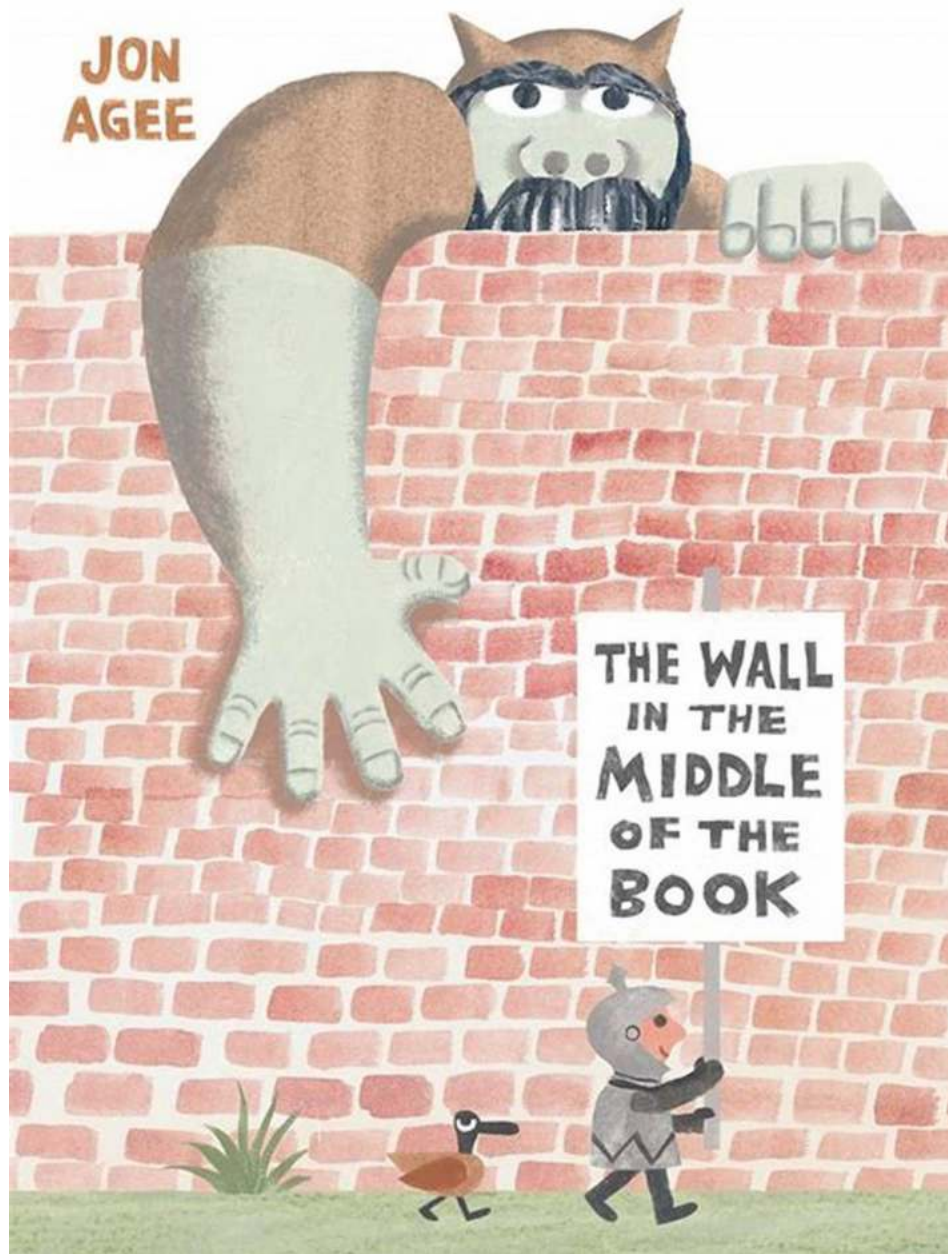

3. "The Wall"

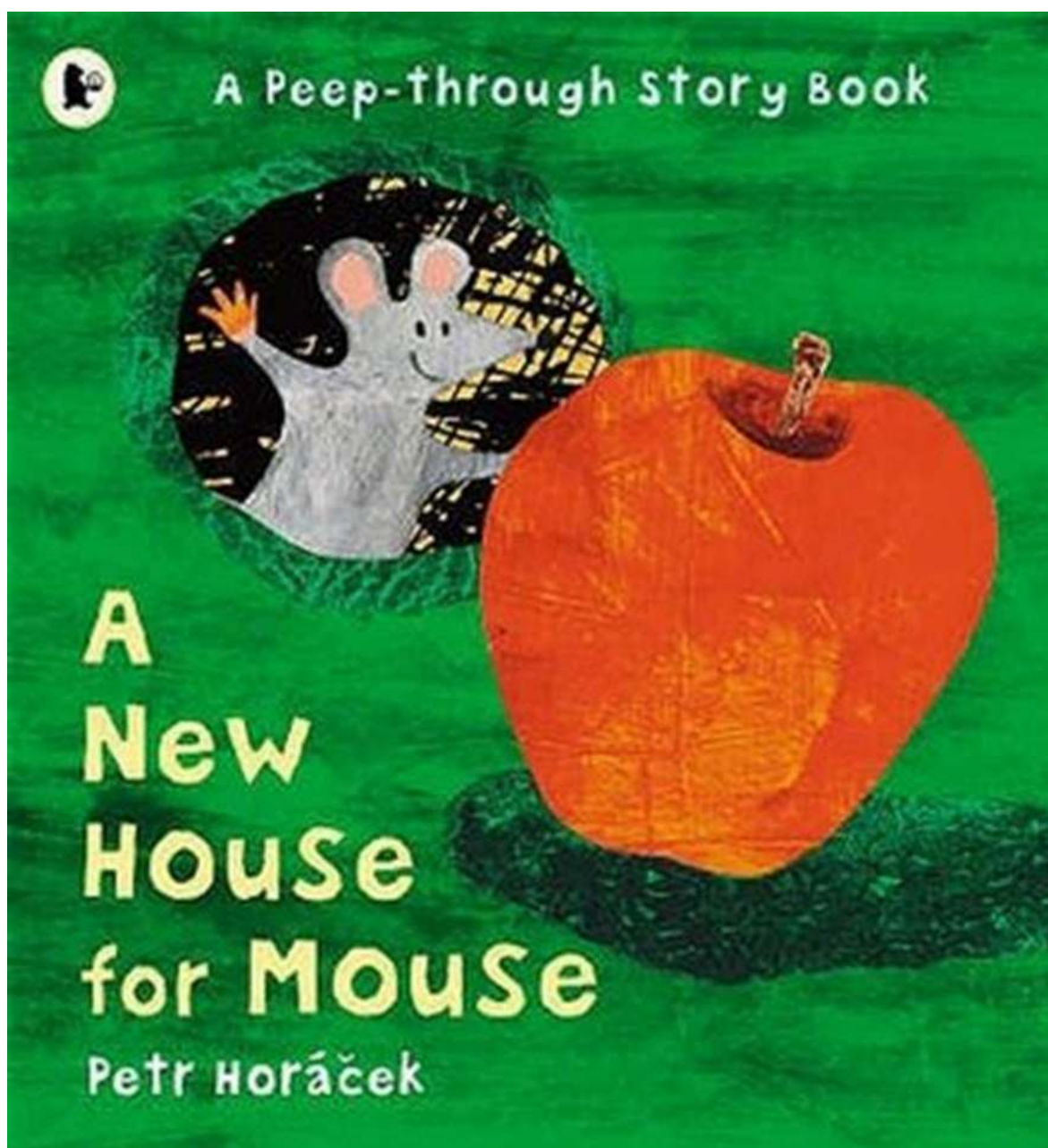

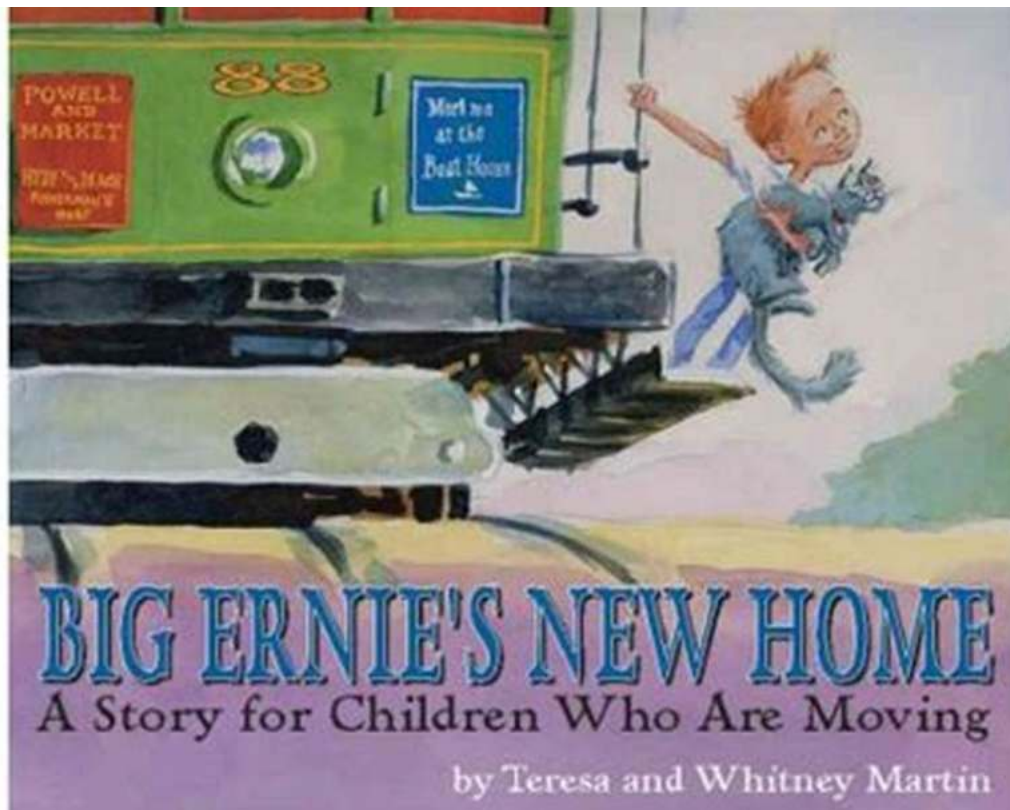
4. "A New House for Mouse"

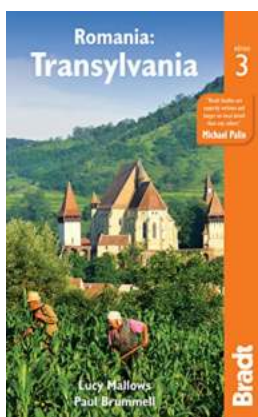

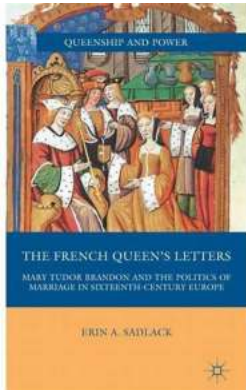

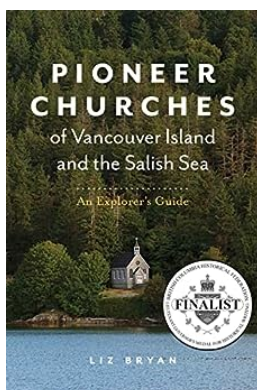
