“”	<p>Quotation Marks Use to show the beginning and ending of what someone is saying. "I love playing sport" said Jenny.</p>
-	<p>Hyphen Use to join words together. My eight-year-old boy loves reading. I work part-time.</p>
'	<p>Apostrophe Use when showing ownership or to show a missing letters Jimmy's dog is called Spot! They're going to the movies tonight.</p>

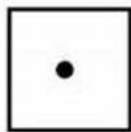

3. Spelling:

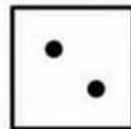

practice spelling words from different word families and focus on commonly misspelled words. Utilize online resources and interactive activities to reinforce spelling skills.

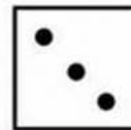
