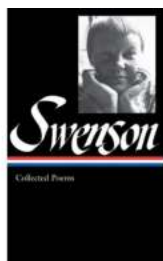

Swenson was an inveterate reviser: poems in earlier volumes were frequently reworked for inclusion in later volumes, such as *To Mix with Time* (1963) and *New and Selected Things Taking Place* (1978). While preserving the order of publication, this volume presents the author's final or definitive version. Substantive textual variants and title changes are detailed in the notes to the volume.

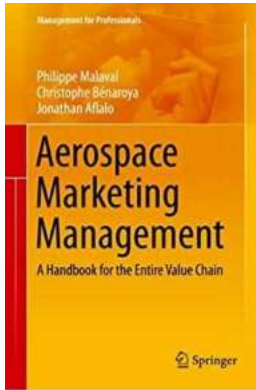

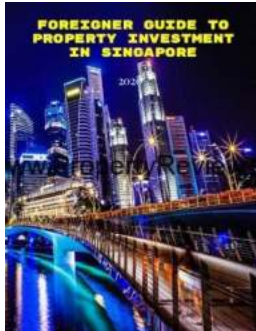

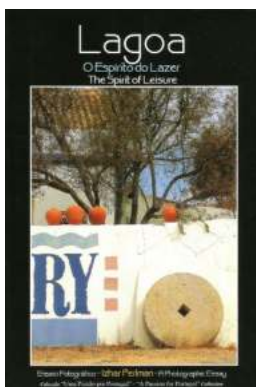
