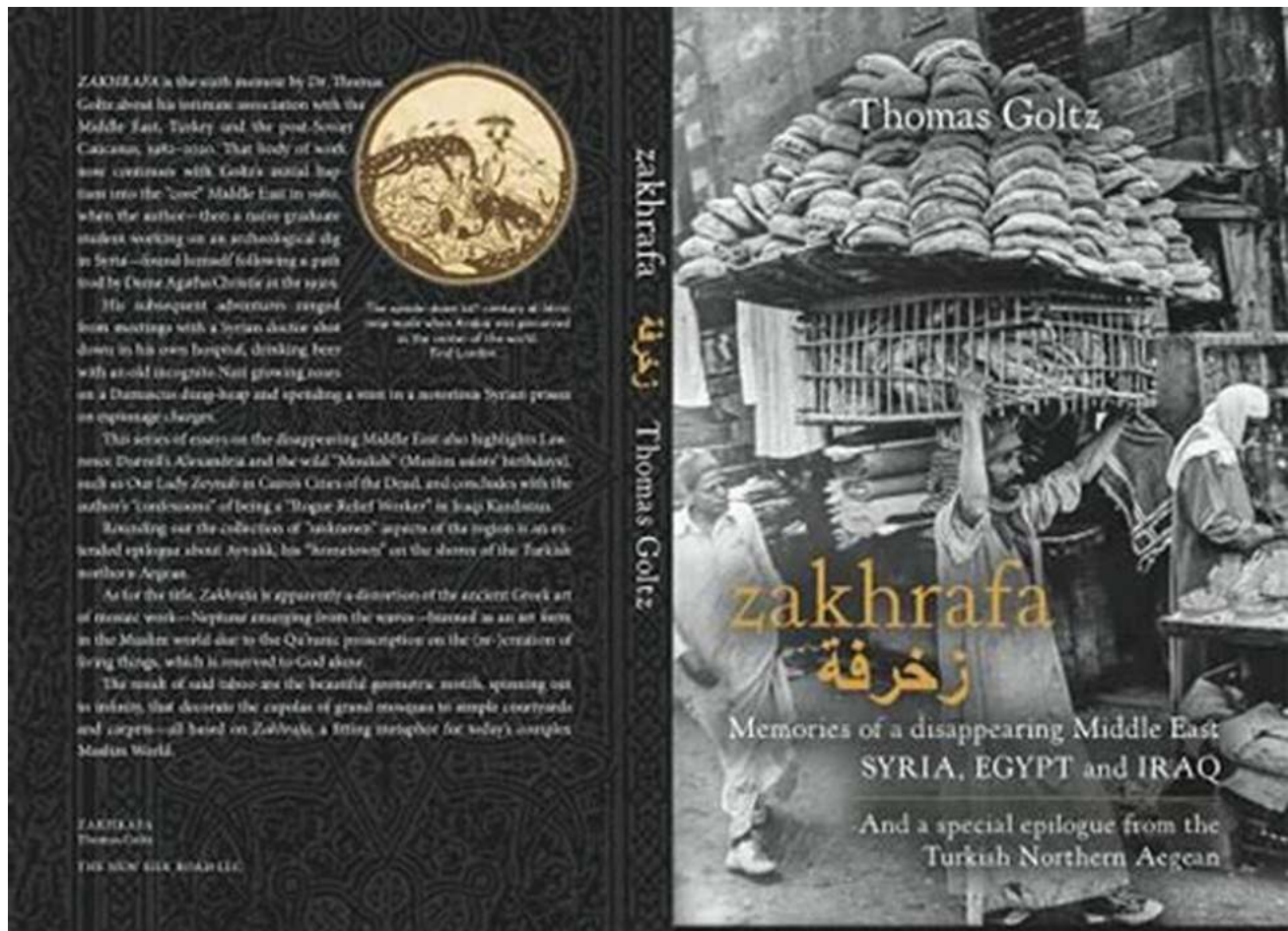

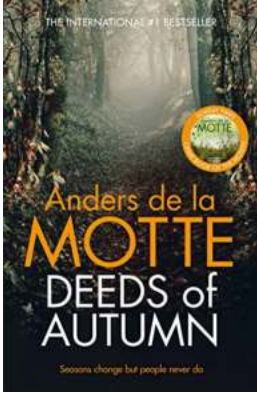

The book concludes with a special epilogue on the Turkish northern Aegean town of Ayvalik, the author's Middle Eastern "hometown" for the past 40 years.
