The sound of a blue whale may reach 188 decibels, making it louder than a jet, which is 140 decibels.

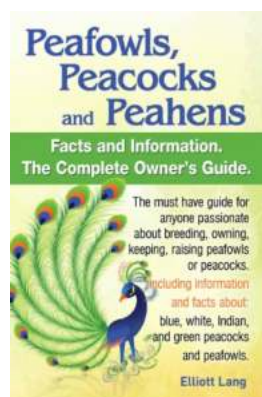
