Some of the landmarks and locations visited by the Bramsons tours in the 1920s are still fixtures of modern-day Montreal, like McGill University and St. Catherine Street.



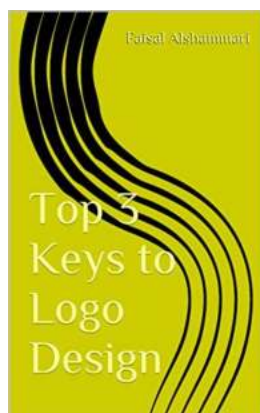

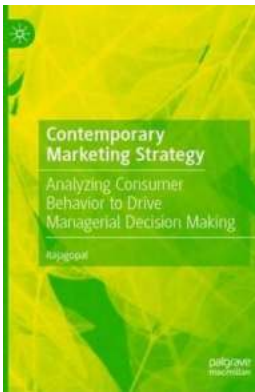

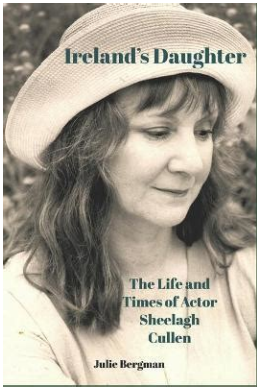
