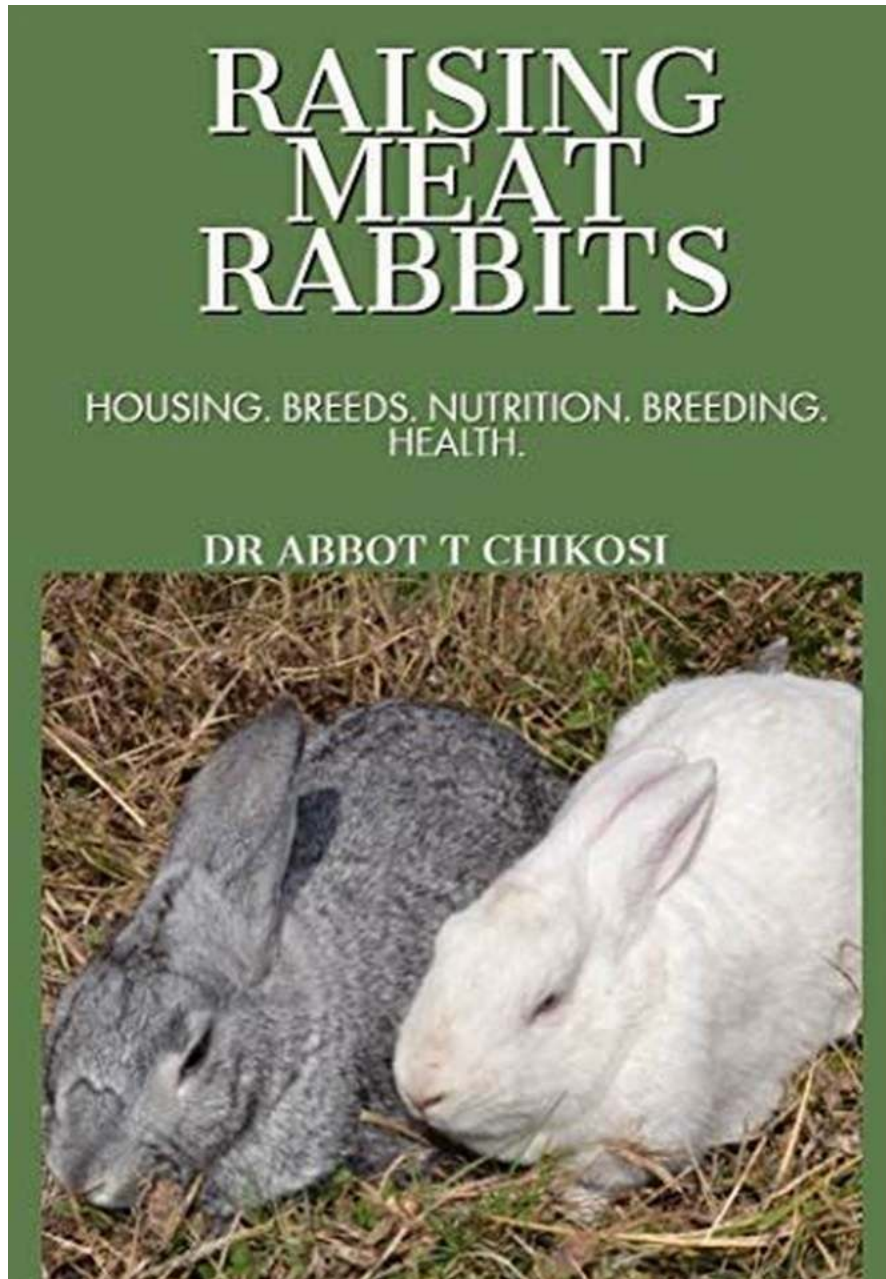

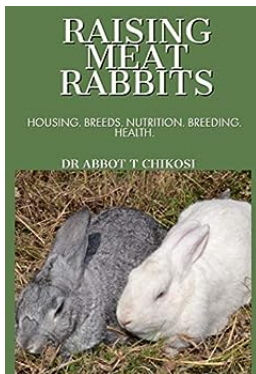

- > Ears erect and thin
- > Well fleshed on back and haunches
- > Puberty - (M) 6½ - 7 mths
- (F) 5½ - 6 mths



Flemish Giant

- > White or beige
- > Long erect ears
- > Puberty - (M) 6 - 7 mths
- (F) 6 - 6½ mths



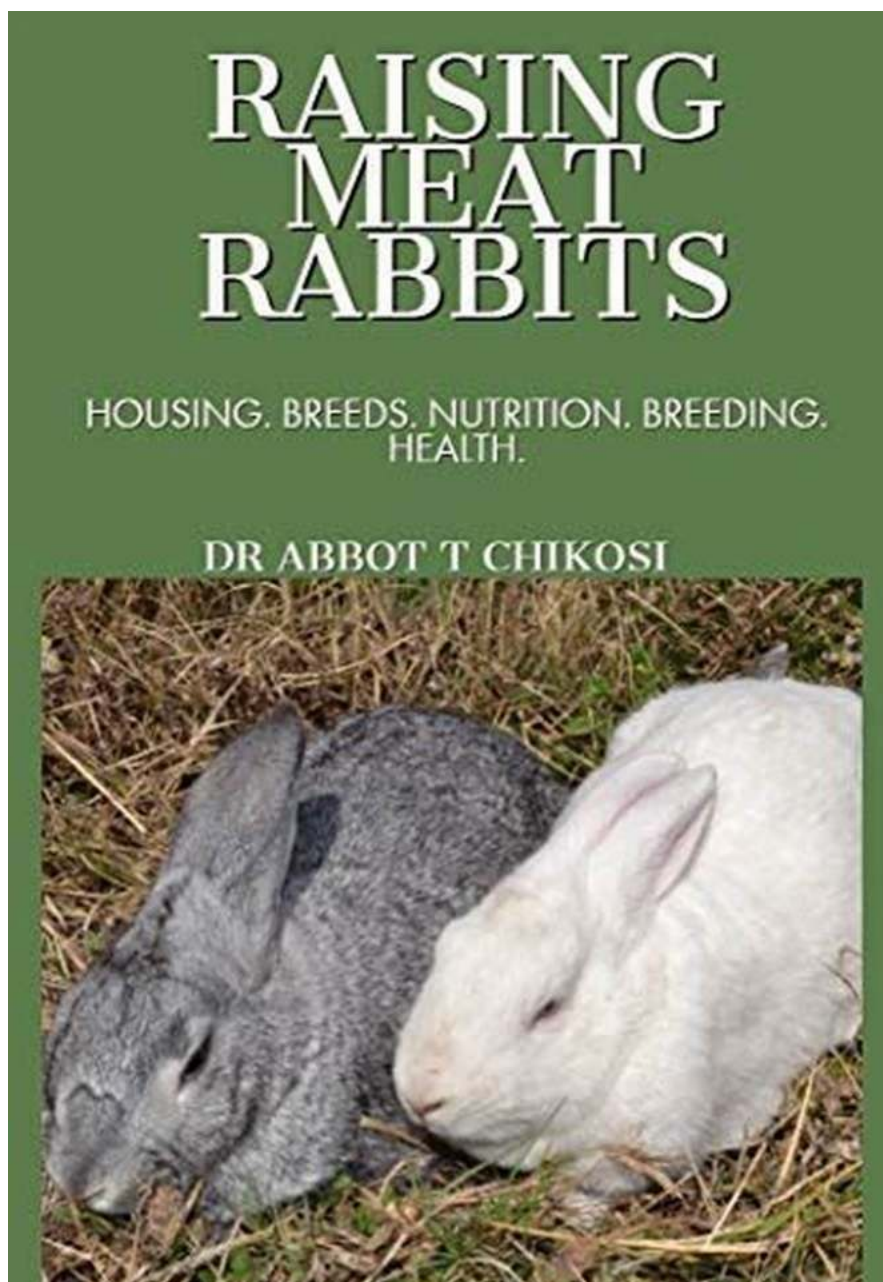
