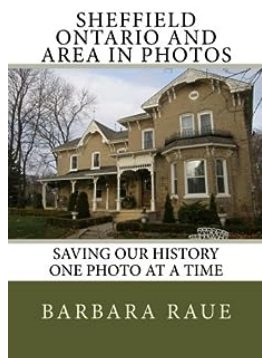

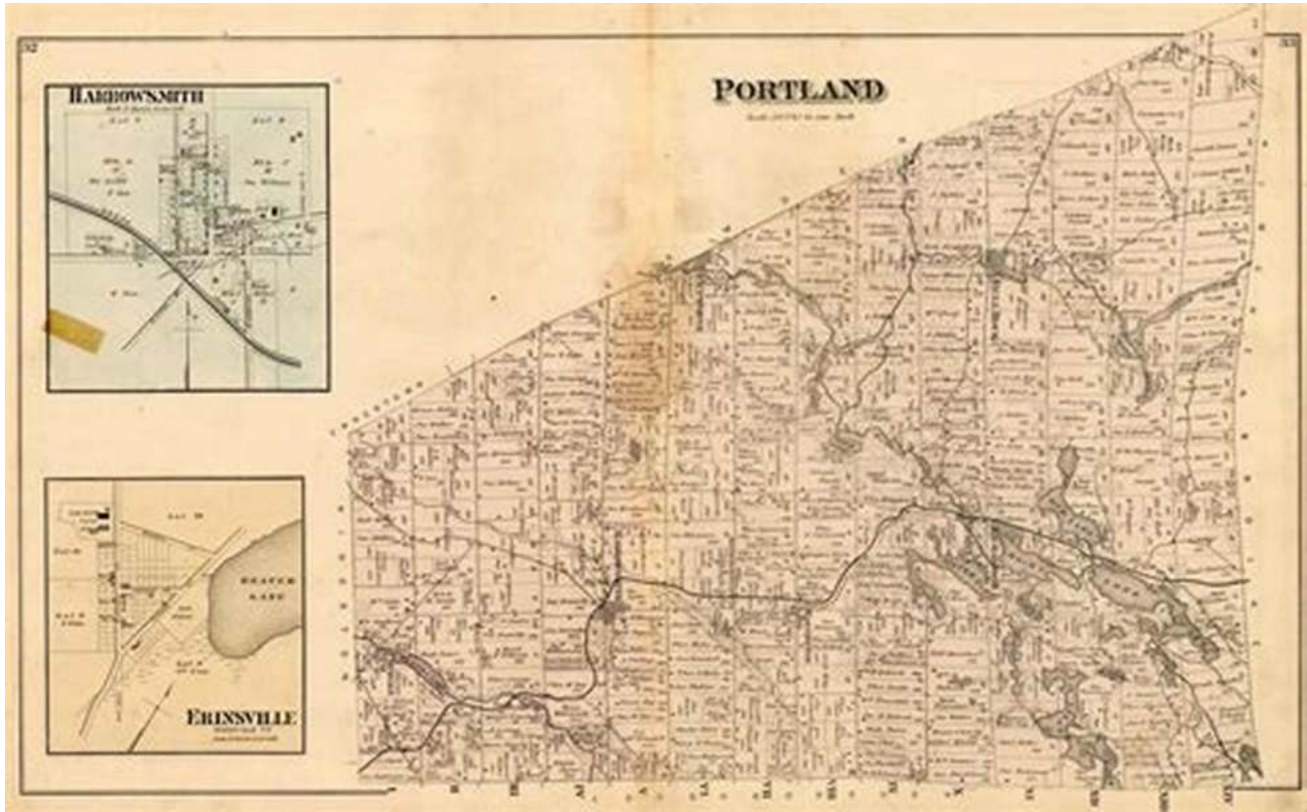

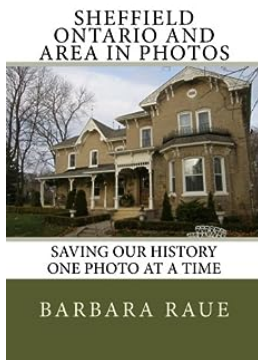

Sheffield

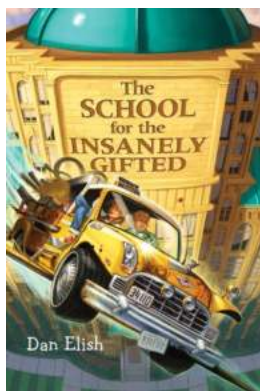

Westfield Heritage Village is located at 1049 Kirkwall Road off Highway 8 west of Rockton. It has over thirty historical buildings which have been restored.



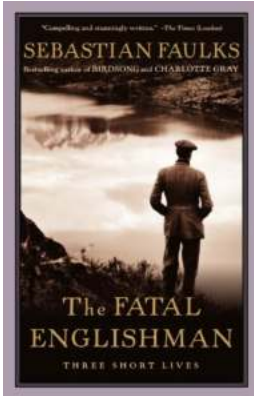

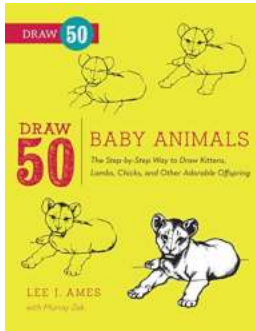
