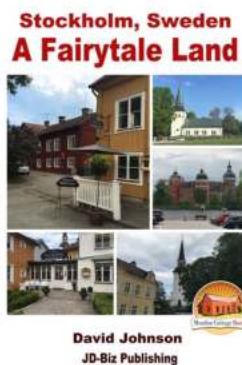

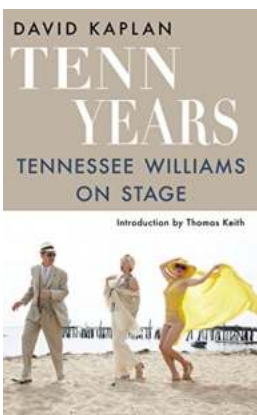
country boasts of being the third largest country in the whole of Europe with over 9 million inhabitants.
