nightclubs and a bonus section covering breakfast. Everything you need and nothing you don't, and for much less than the other guides.

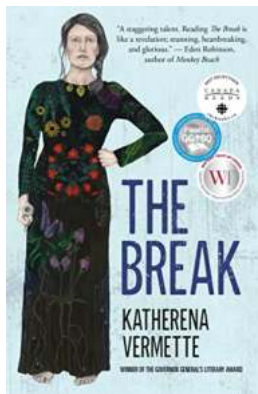
