

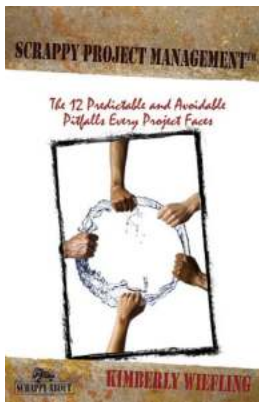

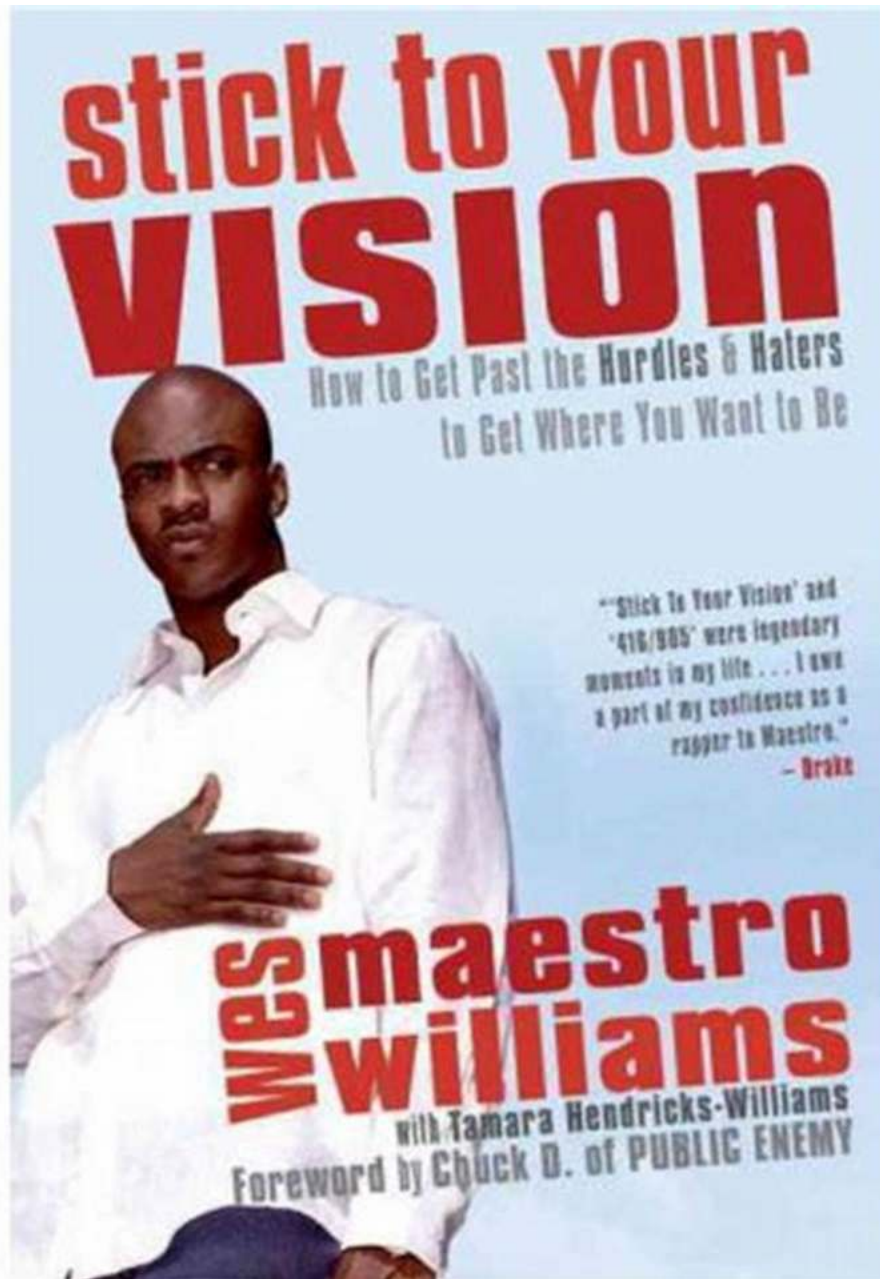
5. Poor Risk Management

Accept others' thoughts and experiences as true for them. Hear others differences as additive.

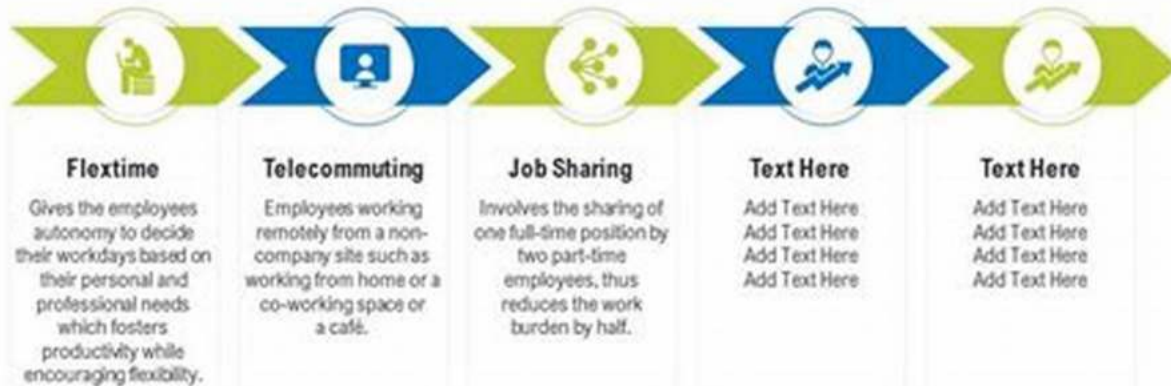
