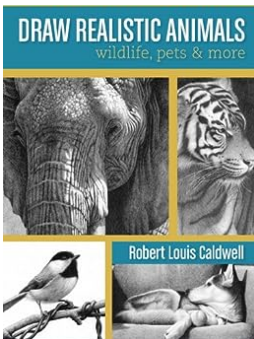
Travel in the wheeltracks of history
