

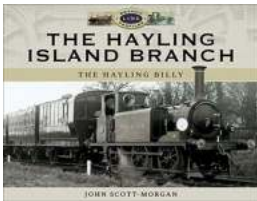

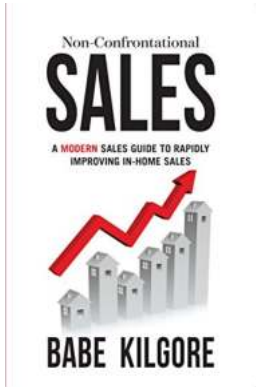


This British Railways history presents an in-depth look at the iconic seaside line that brought residents and visitors to the tiny English Channel island.
