“I feel in my spirit, you are the one Our Father has sent to me as a wife. I must just convince you of that,” Spotted Dog chuckled.



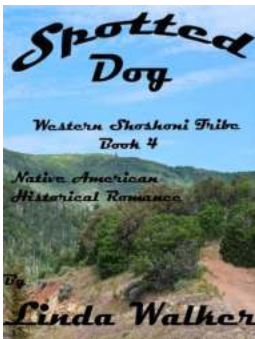
