

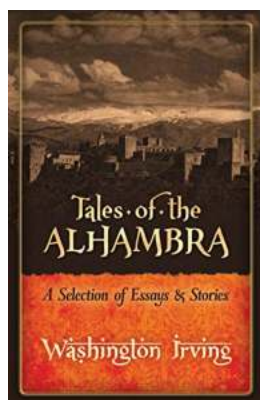

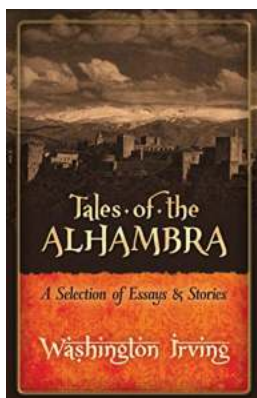

THE MONSTER

The literature circle for Stephan Crane's *The Monster* was thought provoking for me because the new information brought in by other students contextualized the story. Although the story was written in an authoritative tone, Drew as the life and times thinker informed me that, while Crane wrote about issues of race, he was himself a white man. The other pieces of horror or gothic literature we read with strong themes of black identity were written by African-Americans, so it was interesting to compare stories such as Toni Morrison's *Beloved* and Richard Wright's *The Man Who Lived Underground* to *The Monster*. In doing so, my group and I began to see places in which Crane described black characters and white characters differently in ways that seemed biased that I had not noticed before. Although the black characters in *Beloved* and *The Man Who Lived Underground* are deeply humanized, sympathetic, and complex, Johnson is more of a caricature. For example, when the young white boys use words they don't know the meanings of it is "fashionable," but when black characters do the same, they are putting on airs. Knowledge of the writer's experience and identity helped me notice these ways in which the narrative subtly focalized or uplifted white characters without doing the same for the black protagonist.
