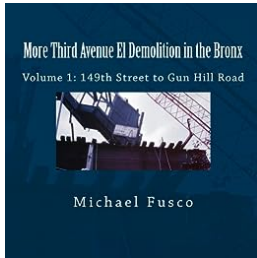

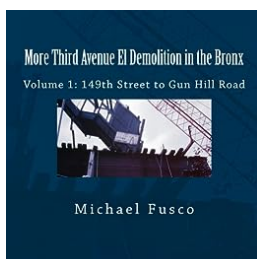

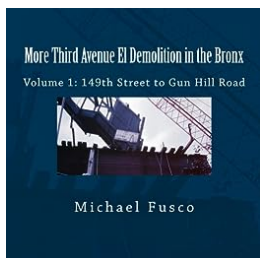
These books will not only appeal to train fans but to fans of autos, buses, the 1970's, Bronx and New York history.

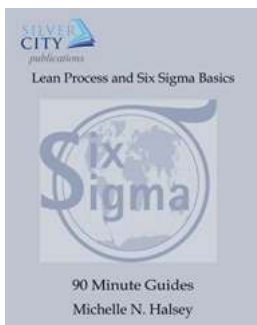

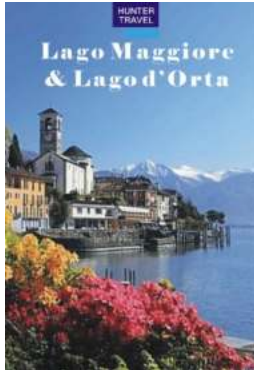
