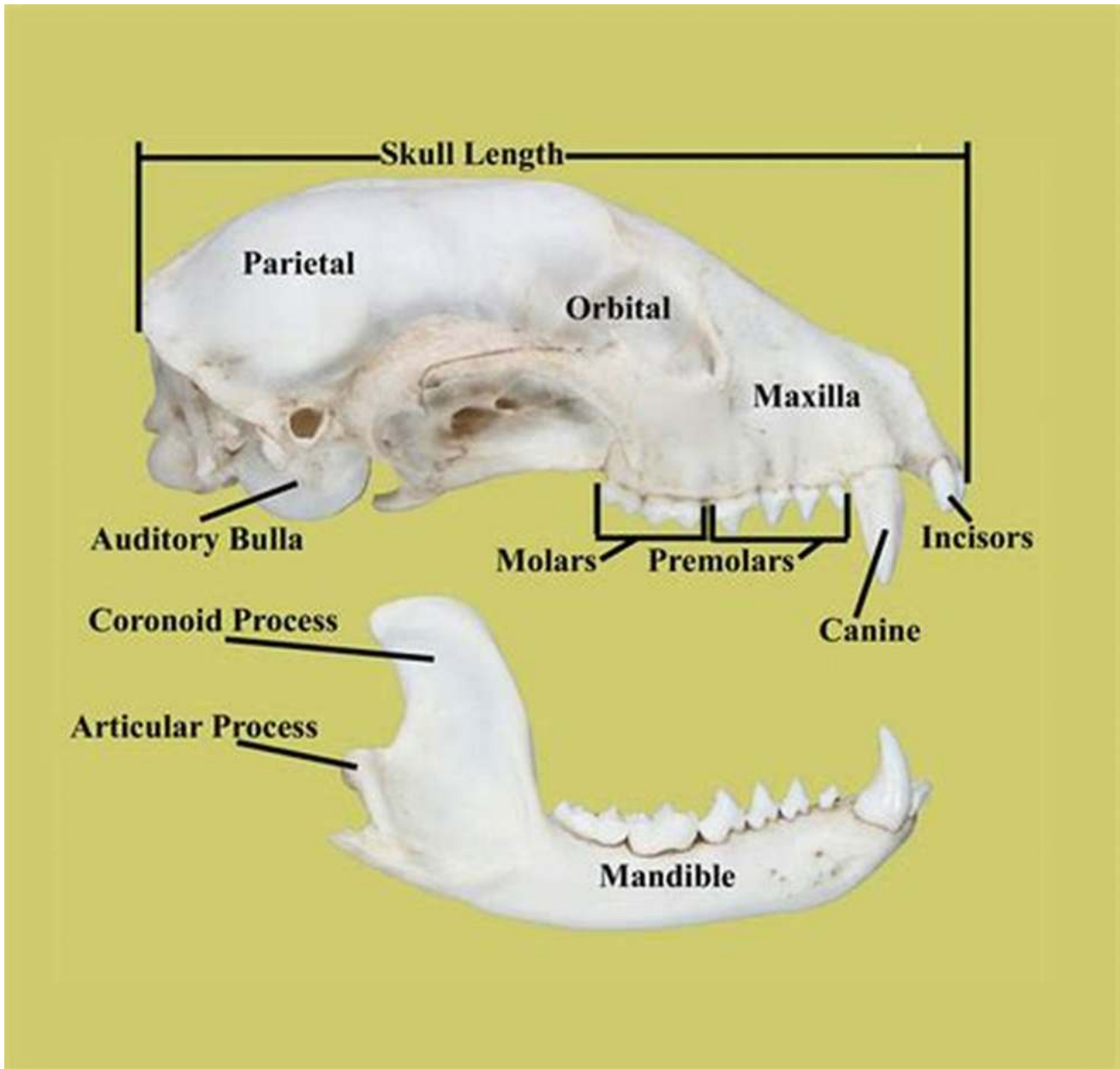
Bones of the Skull - Cranium and Face
