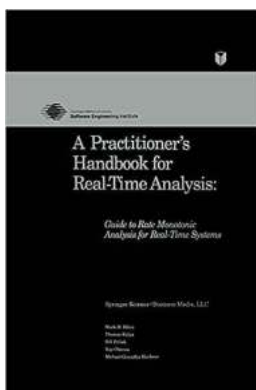

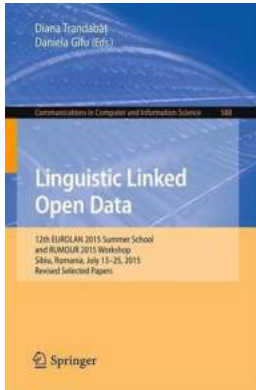
About the author
