THE ANALECTS OF CONFUCIUS

Confucius (551 BC – 479 BC) was a Chinese teacher, politician, and philosopher during the Zhou Dynasty. His teachings were based on traditional Chinese beliefs regarding kinship, ancestor worship, and respect of elders by their children and of husbands by their wives. He also recommended family as the basis for social government. He argued that the well-known Golden Rule: "Do not do to others what you do not want done to yourself." Fades after his death, his teachings were compiled in the *Analects* - *Confucius's teachings from the Analects are below. In which the "Master" is Confucius. The numbers refer to the book first, then section.*



- 1.3 The Master said: To guide a state through to possess a thousand war chariots, be attentive to affairs and trustworthiness, regulate expenditures and treat persons as valuable, employ the people at the proper season.
- 1.16 The Master said: Do not be concerned that no one recognizes your merits, be concerned that you may not recognize others."
- 2.1 The Master said: When one rules by means of virtue, like the North Star – it dwells in its place and the other stars pay reverence to it.
- 2.3 The Master said: Guide them with policies, and align them with punishments and the people will hate them and have no shame. Guide them with virtue and align them with it and the people will have a sense of shame and fulfill their roles.
- 2.14 The Master said: When I was 15, I set my heart on learning. At 30 I set my mind. At 40 I was without confusion. At 50 I knew the command of Heaven. At 60 I heard it with a compliant ear. At 70 I follow the desires of my heart and do not overstep the bounds.
- 3.11 The Master said: A person who can bring new warmth to the old while understanding the new is worthy to take on a teacher.
- 3.13 The Master said: If you study but don't reflect you'll be lost. If you reflect but don't study, you'll get into trouble.
- 3.19 Duke Ai asked, "What should I do so that the people will obey?" Confucius replied, "Raise up the straight and set them above the crooked and the people will obey. Raise up the crooked and set them above the straight and the people will not obey."
- 4.14 The Master said: Do not be concerned that you have no position, be concerned that you have what is able to merit a position. Do not be concerned that no one recognizes you, seek that which is worthy of recognition.
- 4.22 The Master said: Virtue is never alone, it always has neighbors.
- 12.19 Ji Kangui asked Confucius about government, saying, "How would it be all right to rule those who are without the dao in order to bring order to the dao?" Confucius replied, "Of what use is killing in your governance? If you decree goodness, the people will be good. The virtue of the junzi (gentleman) is like the wind, and the virtue of common people is like the grasses; when the wind blows over the grasses, they will surely bend."
- 15.11 The Lord of Shu inquired of Confucius, saying, "There is an upright man in my district. His father stole a sheep, and he testified against him." Confucius said, "The upright men in my district are different. Fathers cover up for their sons and sons cover up for their fathers. 'Tianxiang has the way!'"
