

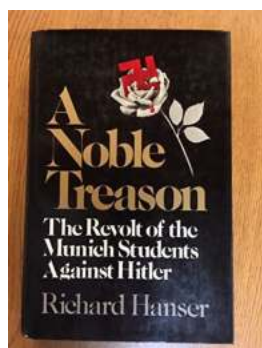
The Untold Story: The Revolt Of The Munich Students Against Hitler
