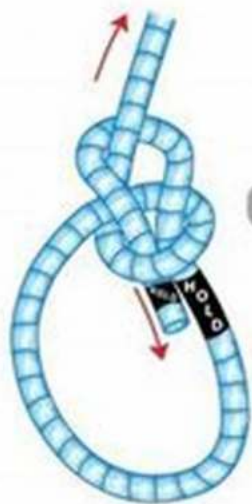
Bowline Knot Directions

3 Hold the loop and tag end and pull to tighten

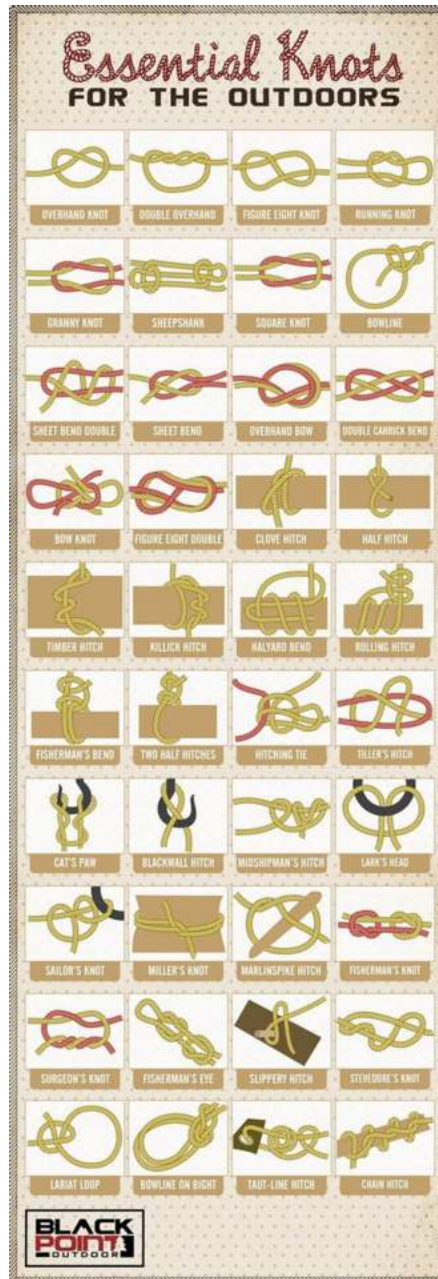


4 The knot is made

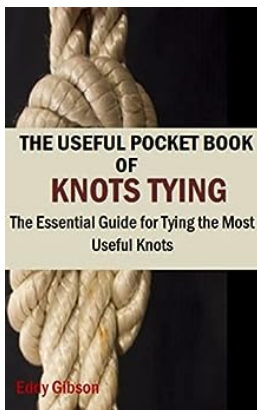

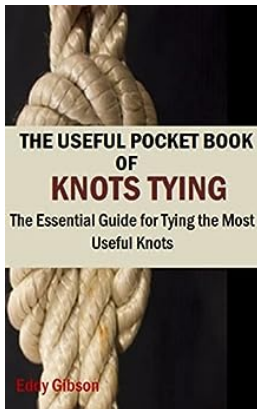


A knot is a way of connecting linear material in a secure manner, such as rope, by tying or interweaving the material together multiple times.

It may be made up of a length of rope, string, twine, or even chain that has been interwoven to provide the line the ability to bind to itself or to another object.

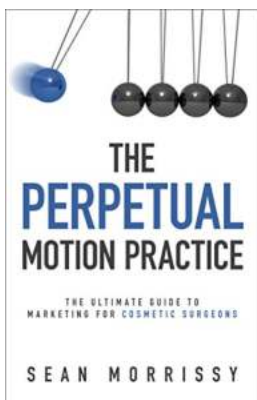
