The collection is prefaced by an from Edward Bond, one of contemporary theatre's most prolific dramatists.



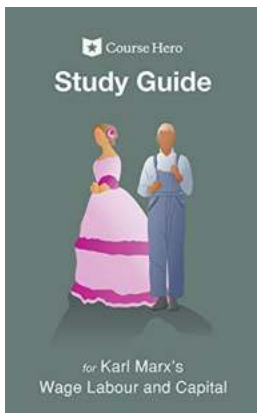

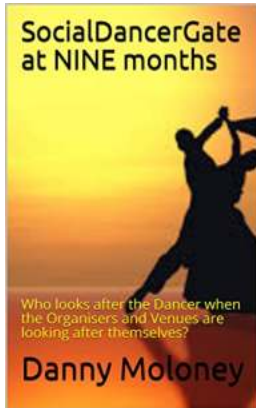

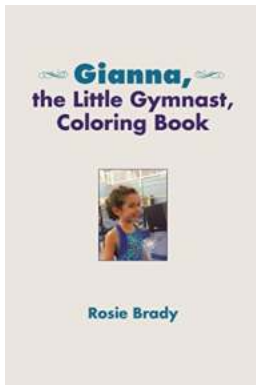
