

How to Crochet the Catherine Wheel Bavarian Stitch

- 8. Repeat steps 5 and 6 until you have achieved the desired length for your project.
- 9. Finish off your work with a neat edging, and voila! You have successfully completed the Catherine Wheel Bavarian stitch.


