

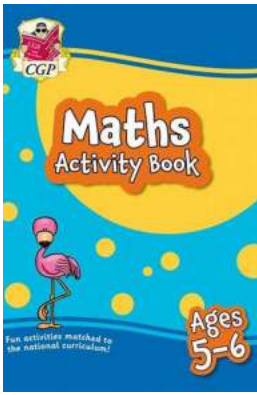

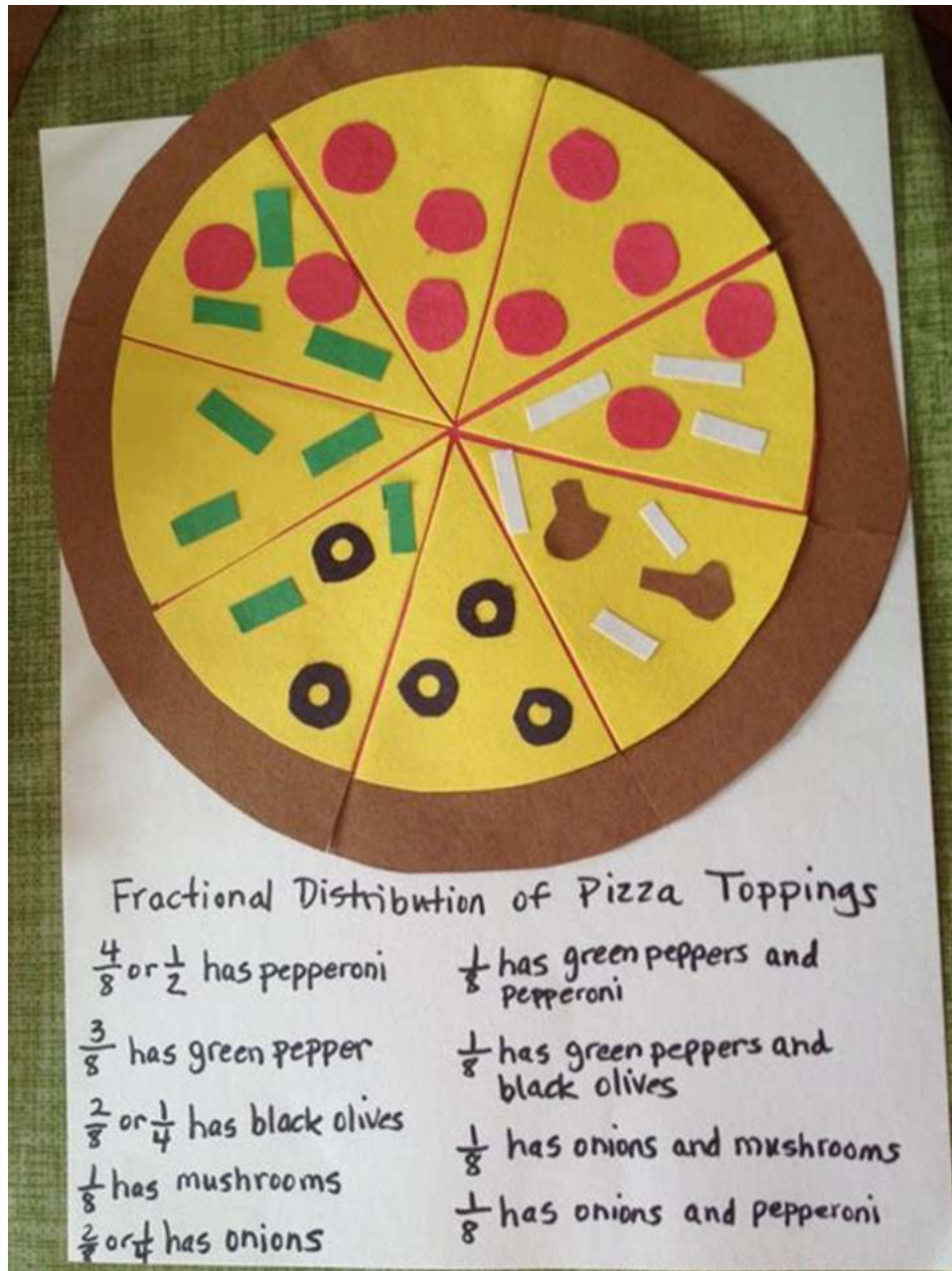

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## Primary School Activities






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**Question 4**

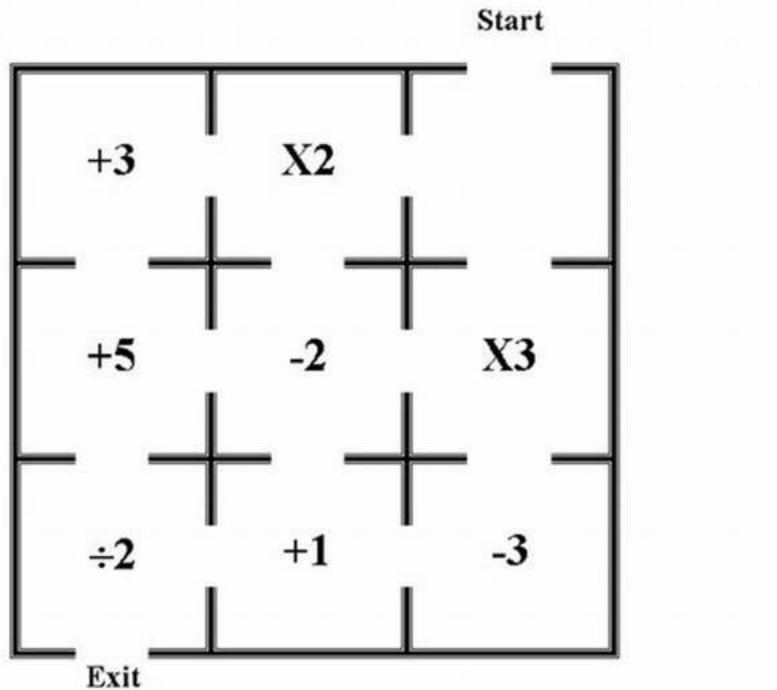
