BEGINNING SLIP KNOT

This knot will be the starting point for every crochet pattern you choose to do.

STEP 1



Make a loop, pull another loop through it.

STEP 2

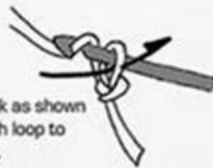


Gently tighten the knot towards the hook.

CHAIN STITCH (CH)

This stitch come after your beginning slip knot and creates the base line for every pattern you create.

STEP 1



Wrap yarn over hook as shown and pull yarn through loop to create another loop.

STEP 2

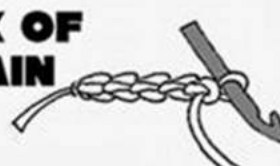


This counts as one chain
- repeatly do step 1 until you reach the desired number of chains.
