This is a collection of stories, essays and poems by 37 individuals connected to the Irish agricultural community.

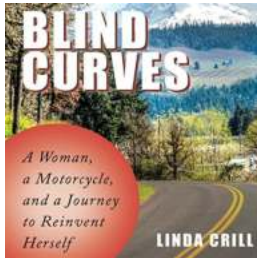

This booklet has been produced as part of the 2021-2022 Writer-in-Residency at Maynooth University, a position in coordination with the Kildare County Arts Council.



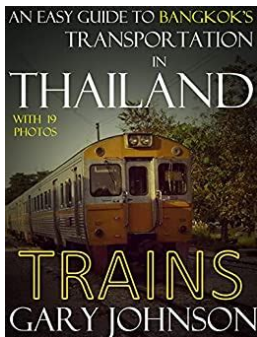
