

2. Letter Tracing

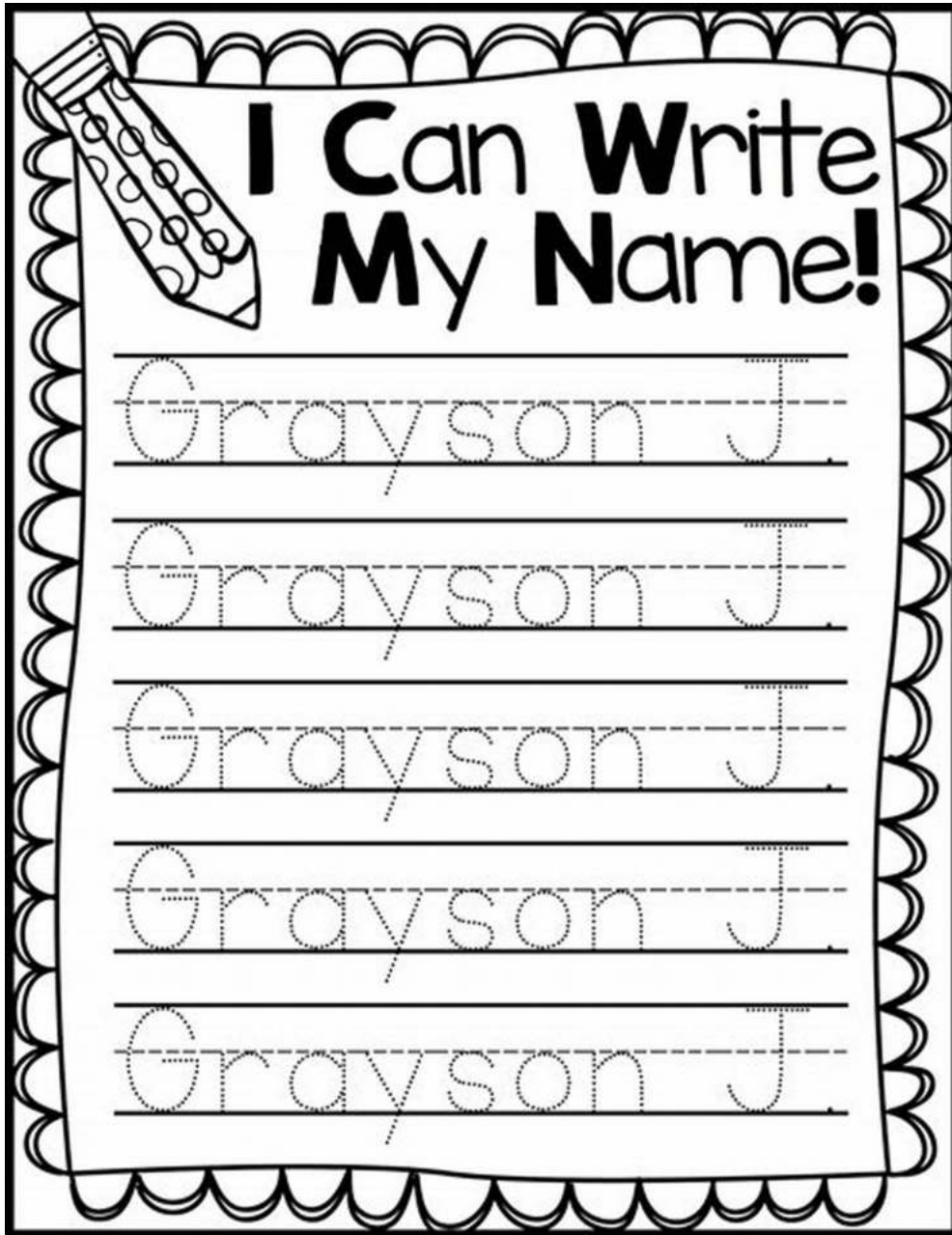






3. Name Writing
